KKB Engineering wins 3 contracts worth RM87.7m

KKB Engineering Bhd has received three contracts worth about RM87.7 million including one from Sabah Electricity Sdn Bhd (SESB) for the supply and delivery of steel high tension poles. The second contract is a supply order from PPES Works-PCSB joint venture's (PPES-PCSB) proposed Kipali interchange project for the fabrication and supply of steel pipes and specials. Its associate company OceanMight Sdn Bhd also received a letter of award from Talisman Malaysia Ltd for the engineering, procurement and construction of the Bunga Pakma Wellhead Riser Platform. The completion date for the Talisman project is the third-quarter of 2017 (3Q17), while the SESB and PPES-PCSB contracts are scheduled to end by the 3Q16, its exchange filing yesterday noted.
