TNB eyes anti-graft certification by 2018

TENAGA Nasional Bhd (TNB) is embarking on a two-year journey to obtain an ISO 37001 certification — Anti-Bribery Management System — by the last quarter of 2018.

In a statement yesterday, chief integrity development officer Kamal Ariffin Abdullah said the certification — the first ever for a government-linked company in Malaysia — will provide international communities and investors the assurance that TNB has adequate procedures and safeguards against bribery.

"It will also enhance TNB's reputation as a corporation that possesses high integrity and an uncompromising stand against corruption," Kamal Ariffin added.

To realise this goal, it has — since February this year — been developing a TNB Corporate Integrity Management System (TCIMS), which is based on the certification.

Among others, the TCIMS covers elements such as due diligence, policies on specific high risk bribery areas, antimoney laundering and whistleblowing. — *Bernama*
